

Responsibilities of the Commissioner of Diversity Affairs

- a. Being generally responsible for communication between the ASUC and different students of color, womyn, LGBTIQ, the disabled community and other underrepresented, marginalized and/or minority populations.
- b. Directing any needs of underrepresented students of color, women, LGBTIQ, and the disabled community to the attention of the Senate.
- c. Suggesting the appropriate course of action to address said needs.
- d. Working with the Executive Vice-President to regularly coordinate diversity training for ASUC Senators, Executives, staff, and other ASUC sponsored student groups. Additionally the Commission shall have the ability to work in cross-coalition and collaborative work with all ASUC executive offices should necessary programming and projects entail accordingly.
- e. Recruiting and selecting a staff as appropriate to carry out the duties of the position.
- f. Making contact at the beginning of each semester with leaders of each organization, detailing how the ASUC can help students of color, women, LGBTIQ, and the disabled community.
- g. Maintaining communication between the ASUC, campus units, and administrators that deal with issues of diversity, which include, but are not limited to, Disabled Students Program, Hate/Bias Task Force, Gender Equity Center, and Title IX.
- h. Preparing a monthly report evaluating the ASUC on issues of diversity, providing constructive criticism for the purposes of improvement.
- i. Helping coordinate all ASUC programming that deals with issues of diversity.
- j. Required to hold weekly office hours on the second floor.
- k. Actively participating in the ASUC Committee for the Fund of Culture Shows and the ASUC Committee for the Multicultural Fund as a voting member.
 - l. All other duties as assigned by the Senate
- l. Under 9.21 Section 3: Section 3 from the previous charter will for the purposes of the new charter be relegated to Section 4.
- m. Under 9.21 Section 3: Section 3l will entail the allocation of a budget for the Commission from the Senate. The Commission acknowledges that in order to obtain a budget from the Senate it will have to apply for Spring Budgeting with the ASUC Financial Committee.
