
A Bill In Support of the Success of the ASUC's Voter Registration Efforts

WHEREAS, the External Affairs Vice President's Vote Coalition serves as Berkeley's official voter registration program; and

WHEREAS, the University of California Students Association's recommendation for achieving this year's EAVP goal of registering twelve thousand voters stipulated a need of the following from now until the voter registration deadline, October 22:

1. Over 100 hours of tabling per week
2. An average of 26 hours of class and student organization presentations per week,
3. Approximately 100 volunteers to commit one half hour of their time on October 8th and two hours of their time on October 11th for one period of door-to-door registration effort in the residence halls; and

WHEREAS, ASUC Executives and Senators are elected representatives of the student body who should engage in mobilizing students and educating them on the electoral process as well as legislation affecting the future of the University; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that all ASUC elected offices affirm the legacy of UC Berkeley's student activism and political engagement by making a good faith effort to commit to volunteering with the Vote Coalition two hours a week.
